Morgan Aronson is the National Single Audit Coordinator with the U.S. Department of the Interior, Office of Inspector General, where her responsibilities include managing the Single Audit Team, supervising the completion of single audit desk reviews and quality control reviews, and serving as the Department's single audit liaison with the Office of Management and Budget, the Federal Audit Clearinghouse, and other federal agencies and groups.
