Tom is a Financial Analyst with the United States Department of Health and Human Services (HHS), Office of Finance (OF). In this capacity, Tom reviews and approves the senior level audit resolution of findings included in Single audit reports received by the OIG, and is working to promote leadership across all HHS audit resolution offices.

Prior to joining HHS in April 2008, Tom was a Staff Director in EPA's Office of Finance overseeing the President's Management Agenda for Improved Financial Performance and EPA's program and cost accounting implementation, with an emphasis in the Superfund cost recovery area. In carrying out this function, Tom also served as an Expert Witness providing deposition and trial testimony on EPA's indirect cost accounting methodology for Superfund cost recovery. Prior to his 18 year tenure at EPA, Tom served as an auditor at both the Defense Contract Audit Agency, and a small CPA firm.
